Ideal: 3 or more well placed blooms, evidence of further bloom on strong stalks with good balance

Definitions:

- 1. **Bicolour –**Falls of one colour and standards of another distinct colour
- 2. Bitones Falls of one tone and standards of another tone of the same basic colour
- 3. Plicata Stitched or stippled margin of colour on white background
