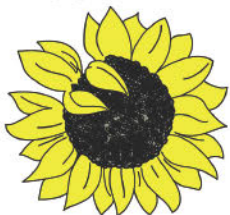

Join us for an evening with guest speaker **Gini Sage** and her presentation ***Square Food Gardening and Companion Planting***. Square foot gardening is the practice of dividing the growing area into small square sections to intensively plant a vegetable garden. There is more interest than ever in creating small vegetable gardens on residential plots and this presentation covers how to get started even if you have no more than a 4' x 4' space. In addition, the application of these principles to herb and flower gardens is shown. Companion planting covers how plants can benefit each other by being planted in proximity to each other. This helps in pest control, pollination, providing habitat for beneficial creatures and maximizing the use of your space. Both techniques, when used together, can maximize the health and yield of your garden.
