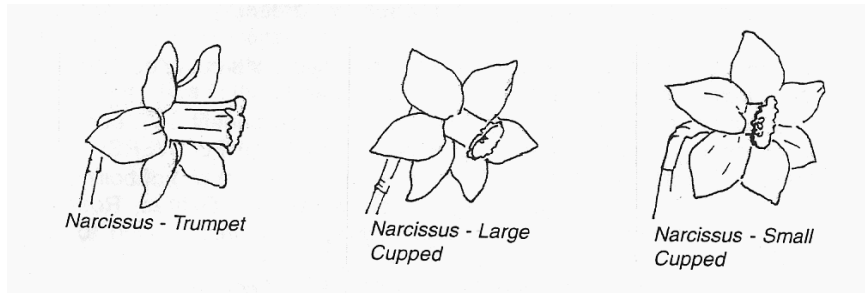

### DIVISION I HORTICULTURE

All specimen classes are OPEN; you may enter TWO ITEMS but they must be different cultivars. Exception to this rule will be specified where applicable.

#### Section 'A' Narcissus

- Do not show Narcissus with foliage
- 'Trumpet': the trumpet is as long or longer than the surrounding petals
- 'Large-cupped': the cup is more than 1/3 of, but less than equal to, the petals
- 'Small-cupped': not more than 1/3 the size of the surrounding petals



- NIP: Named if possible

| 10. Narcissus collection, 3 different cultivars (NIP)    | 3 scapes |

#### Section 'B' Other Bulbs or Specimens

| 11. Chionodoxa, any colour.....                       | 3 stems      |
| 12. Hyacinth, any colour (do not show foliage).....   | 1 scape      |
| 13. Tulip, any colour or type,.....                   | 1 bloom/stem |
| 14. Hellebore.....                                    | 1 stem       |
| 15. Any other bulb, corm, rhizome or tuber (NIP)..... | 3 blooms     |
| 16. Any other bulb corm, rhizome or tuber (NIP).....  | 3 stems      |
| 17. Any other flower (NIP).....                       | 3 blooms     |
| 18. Any other flower (NIP).....                       | 3 stems      |

**Section 'C' Branches of Trees, Shrubs and Vines**

- 19. Flowering branch, UNDER 76 cm (30") (NIP)..... 1 branch
- 20. Any Branch/ Vine, showing only foliage, UNDER 76 cm (30") (NIP) ..... 1 branch

**Section 'D' Cuttings and Seedlings**

- 21. Seedlings for transplant, 4-6 seedlings, must be named .....  
..... suitable container
- 22. Plant grown from a cutting 'taken in the last year', must be named .....1 pot

**Section 'E' Container Grown Plants**

All containers max 25cm / 10" (see 'Houseplants' in Definition of Terms)

- 23. African Violet (Saintpaulia), any type .....1 pot
- 24. Geranium (Pelargonium) .....1 pot
- 25. Orchid.....1 pot
- 26. Plant grown for bloom (NIP).....1 pot
- 27. Plant grown for foliage (NIP) .....1 pot

Where possible, please provide the name(s) of plant material used in your design.

- 28. "Fanciful"..... Indoor planter incorporating spring bulbs  
container - max 30cm/12 inches

- 30. You create a title .....an interpretation of your own title. Display a title card.
